In order to select participants who will be featured in Pariksha Pe Charcha programme, an online creative writing competition is being conducted at <https://www.mygov.in/> on various topics (Annexure-I) during 28th December 2021 to 20th January 2022 for children studying in classes of 9 to 12, teachers and parents. About 2050 winners will receive a certificate signed by Director, NCERT and a special PPC Kit comprising of Exam Warriors book in Hindi and English, written by Hon'ble Prime Minister.

Further, all the Heads of Govt., Govt. Aided, and Un-Aided Recognized Schools are hereby directed to display the said information on prominent places in the schools, or the information be disseminated during online / offline classes by the teachers, or through any innovative means so that the maximum participation of the students in the above cited event may be ensured.

In addition, the Head of the School shall appoint a teacher under whose guidance the students may participate in the event. The teacher concerned shall keep a consolidated record of the students participating in the event for further submission to the Nodal Officer appointed by the department.
