**CIRCULAR**

**Sub: Regarding Vaccination of Students of age group 15 to 18 years**

As per directions received from Secretary, Gol, Department of Health and Family Welfare, Ministry of H&FW vide D.O. No.2467806/2021/Imm Dated:28/12/2021& SEPIO, DFW vide F.No.6(1038)/CH/DFW/2021-22/9213-21 Dated:31/12/2021 COVID-19 Vaccination of children in the age group of 15-18 years has to be started from 3<sup>rd</sup> January,2022. For such beneficiaries, option for vaccination would only be available for COVAXIN.

Directorate of Education is committed to take all necessary measures to safeguard the students studying in schools of DOE. Keeping in view the recent global surge of COVID-19 cases, detection of Omicron variant which has been categorized as a variant of concern(VOC) It is imperative that Directorate of Education ensures all the Government/Govt. Aided/Private Unaided School Students aged 15 to 18 years( born before 31<sup>st</sup> December 2007) get vaccinated on immediate basis.

Head of all the Schools has an important role to play in ensuring prompt coverage of this age group and is directed to:

1. Identify a Nodal In-charge of the school to coordinate the activity.
2. Prior Registration / Booking should be done on Co-WIN Portal from 1st January 2022 and School ID Card will also be accepted as an ID Proof for the same (in addition to already eligible Ids viz-Aadhar Card). However, all eligible beneficiaries can also walk-in for registration to any nearby Designated 15-18 years CVC, with their ID proof and get vaccinated.
3. Class Teachers of the relevant classes/sections must ensure that parents are informed to take their children to nearest vaccination site (list enclosed) earmarked for vaccination of children between 15 to 18 years of age.
4. In case the school itself has been identified as a CVC for 15 to 18 age group, parents may accompany the children to the school & facilitation in terms of provision of separate room, staff for queue management & verifier should be provided by the Head of the Schools.
5. In addition, if the school is not a CVC, but a temporary camp mode vaccination of its students of this age group is required, the Head of the School will get in touch with the District Immunization Officer so that a mobile team can be positioned for sufficient days depending upon the number of children to be vaccinated. The children can be informed and mobilized to

school on the designated days. Head of the School will provide the necessary space, staff for queue management, verifier and computer/internet connectivity for these days.

6. In case of private schools, the Head of the Schools may get in touch with the private/Govt CVCs to provide school-based camp mode vaccination of their children with due observance of Government operational guidelines for CVCs.

7. List of all COVID-19 vaccination centers/session sites earmarked for this age group in 15 to 18 years shall be published and updated on website of Delhi State Health Mission ([www.dshm.delhi.gov.in](http://www.dshm.delhi.gov.in)).

8. DDE(Districts) and DDE(Zones) are directed to ensure the compliance of the above directions & will also ensure that each head of the school must upload the status of vaccinated students as per below mentioned schedule.

9. Heads of Schools (Govt/Govt. Aided/Private Unaided) shall daily upload the status of vaccinated school students on the Google Tracker (link given below) by 4 PM without fail.

*Dear Colleague,*

The National COVID-19 Vaccination Drive of India, the largest of its kind in the world, has successfully covered around 90% of the eligible beneficiaries with at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine while more than 62% of the eligible beneficiaries have been fully vaccinated. More than 142 crore doses of COVID-19 vaccine have been administered to cover these beneficiaries and this mammoth task has been achieved in shortest possible time, through proactive support of States/UTs.

2. National COVID-19 Vaccination Drive has continuously been guided by scientific evidence and global best practices. Keeping in view the recent global surge of COVID-19 cases, detection of Omicron variant which has been categorized as a Variant of Concern (VOC), scientific evidence, global best practices and the inputs/suggestions of "COVID-19 Working Group" of "National Technical Advisory Group on Immunization (NTAGI)" as well as of "Standing Technical Scientific Committee (STSC)" of NTAGI it has now been decided to further refine the scientific prioritization & coverage of COVID-19 vaccination as follows:

a) COVID-19 Vaccination of children in the age-group of 15-18 years to be started from 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022. For such beneficiaries, option for vaccination would only be available for those who have only received one dose with FUL for the age-group 15-18.

b) As a matter of abundant precaution, for those Health Care Workers & Front Line Workers who have received two doses, another dose of COVID-19 vaccine would be provided from 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022. The prioritization and sequencing of this precaution dose would be based on the completion of 9 months i.e. 39 weeks from the date of administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

c) All persons aged 60 years and above with comorbidities who have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, will on Doctor's advice be provided with a precaution dose from 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022. The prioritization and sequencing of this precaution dose would be based on the completion of 9 months i.e. 39 weeks from the date of administration of second dose.

3. All persons aged 60 years & above with co-morbidities will not be required to produce/submit any certificate from doctor, at the time of administration of precaution dose. Such persons are expected to obtain the advice of their doctor before deciding to avail of the precaution dose.

4. All citizens irrespective of their income status are entitled to free COVID-19 vaccination at Govt. Vaccination Centres. Those who have the ability to pay are encouraged to use Private Hospitals' Vaccination Centres. The previously declared price for each

5. Following features and provisions will be available on Co-WIN to facilitate the vaccination of aforementioned beneficiaries:

**a. HCWs, FLWs and Citizens 60+:**

- All HCWs, FLWs and citizens aged 60 years or above with comorbidities will be able to access the vaccination for precaution dose through their existing Co-WIN account.
- Personnel to be deployed in Election Duty in poll-bound States will also be included in the category of FLWs.
- Eligibility of such beneficiaries for the precaution dose will be based on the date of administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> dose as recorded in the Co-WIN system (completion of 9 months i.e. 39 weeks from the date of administration of second dose).
- All such HCWs and FLWs who are for any reason presently registered on the Co-WIN system as citizens and are aged less than 60 years, will have to get their status appropriately assigned to HCW/FLW to avail the precaution dose. However, in order to do so they must produce the employment certificate in prescribed format. This facility will only be available at Government Vaccination Centers in on-site mode. This can be availed at the time of administration of the precaution dose at Govt. Vaccination Centers.

For such beneficiaries, option for vaccination would only be "Covaxin" as this is the only vaccine with EUL for the age-group 15-18 years & necessary recommendation of "COVID-19 Working Group" of NTAGI.

6. These guidelines will come into effect from 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022 & will be reviewed from time to time.

7. In the poll-bound States, there is possibility of increased instances of crowding, hence, next week and fortnight is crucial in these States to maximize the vaccination coverage. These States must review the implementation of their district-wise vaccination plans on a daily basis to ensure that the speed & coverage of COVID-19 vaccination is enhanced significantly.

8. The State/UT-wise projected number of 15-18 years' age-group provided by Registrar General of India (RGI) is annexed (Annex. 1). The State/UT-wise projected number of co-morbid persons in 60+ age-group is also annexed (Annex.2).

9. I request you to kindly direct the concerned officials to initiate planning for vaccination of aforementioned beneficiaries at earliest. It must also be ensured that due focus on full vaccination of all eligible beneficiaries is sustained while rolling out precaution dose and vaccination of 15-18 years' age-group.

**Sub: Regarding COVID-19 Vaccination of 15-18 years age-group and Precaution Dose to HCWs, FLWs and persons aged ≥ 60 years with co-morbidities**

Directions have been received from MoHFW, GoI via D.O. No. 2467806/2021/Imm., dated: 28<sup>th</sup> December 2021, regarding COVID-19 Vaccination of 15-18 years age-group and administration of Precaution Dose to HCWs, FLWs and persons aged ≥ 60 years with co-morbidities (already shared and copy enclosed).

Based on the scientific prioritization as per NTAGI and STSC recommendations:

- a). COVID-19 Vaccination of children in the age-group of 15-18 years is to be started from 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022 using **Covaxin** only. (as only vaccine with EUL for 15-18 years).
- b). As a precaution, one additional dose of COVID-19 Vaccine is to be provided to Health Care Workers (HCWs), Front Line Workers (FLWs) and all persons aged 60 years and co-morbidities, from 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022, provided that they have received 2 doses and 39 weeks / 9 months have elapsed from the date of administration of 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

The decision regarding vaccine option availability for the cohort of HCWs, FLWs and 60+ age with co-morbidities is awaited from MoHFW and will be communicated subsequently before the commencement of Precaution dose administration.

Regarding Vaccination of 15-18 years age group from 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2022:

- All individuals born before 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2007 (i.e. on or before 2007) will be eligible for COVID-19 Vaccination, with Covaxin as the only option available currently.
- Prior Registration / Booking can be done on Co-WIN Portal from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 and School ID Card will also be accepted as an ID Proof for the same (in addition to already eligible IDs). However, all eligible beneficiaries can also walk-in for registration to any nearby Designated 15-18 years CVC, with their ID proof and get vaccinated.

Guidance for vaccination of 15-18 years without ID card will be the same as used for the eighteen plus category without identity proof.

- It is to be ensured that Covaxin is the only vaccine being administered at the Session Sites designated for 15-18 years age group, with separate queues. Further, as per

operational feasibility, it is recommended to have separate CVCs or atleast separate session sites for 15-18 years age group.

- The dose and route of vaccination are same as before i.e. 0.5ml Covaxin via Intra-muscular (i.m.) route. Further, Vaccination is to be followed mandatorily by the 30 minutes Observation Period.
- All existing COVID-19 Vaccination AEFI Protocols are to be followed as in-toto during their vaccination.
- All district officials are required to ensure that all areas in their district have at least one CVC designated for this age-group. School-based and Facility-based sites are required to be identified in the districts for the same and scaled-up subsequently. Further, all DIOs are required to share the list of such designated CVCs in their district (with complete addresses) with the undersigned, latest by today.
- Private CVCs may provide the vaccination of this age group as per the guidelines shared. Vaccination sessions for 15-18 years can also be organized in Govt. and Private Schools, in collaboration with Govt. CVCs or Private CVCs as Workplace Sessions, in accordance with existing guidelines for organization of the same.

DMs, CDMOs & DIOs are requested to issue necessary instructions to the concerned in this regard.
