THEME FOR MULTIDISCIPLINARY ART INTEGRATION PROJECT FOR CLASS IX: TECHNOLOGY & HUMANITY

General Instructions

- Integrated projects of all subjects can be done in file, model, chart, or in any other creative and innovative way.
- · Credit will be awarded to original ideas, illustrations, and creative use of materials.
- The project needs to be developed and presented in this order:
- Handwritten cover page showing project title, student's name, class, section, school's name, and academic year.
- The Index page should include the names of the subjects, the page no. and a column for the teacher's sign.
- Acknowledgments (acknowledging the institutions and persons who have helped).
- The work is to be done in this sequence only 1. English 2. Hindi 3. Mathematics 4. Science 5. S.St.
- Page limits (for each subject): Minimum 3, Maximum 5 excluding cover page, index page and acknowledgment page.
- All the above instructions are to be followed by the students if they are presenting handwritten project work.
- All the students are advised to complete the project with the resources available at home.
- Prepare a systematic timetable and follow it religiously from the very first day.
- Don't bring Homework on the first day of the reopening of the school.
- The dates for bringing the homework will be intimated later.
- · Use Eco-Friendly material only for making the model.

English:-

Read and analyze: Read a novel or article exploring the impact of technology on human relationships, such as "The Circle" by Dave Eggers or "The Future of the Mind" by Michio Kaku. Write a critical analysis of the text.

• Write an argumentative paragraph on the topic "Artificial intelligence will surpass human intelligence in the near future." It can be for or against the topic.

- These ideas should provide a good starting point for more extensive homework.

Mathematics:-

Part A: Mathematics & Technology:-

(For Roll No. 1 to 25)

- Choose a topic of interest (e.g., screen time, climate change, internet usage, etc.)
- Collect data (you can use websites, apps, or conduct surveys).
- Ø Represent the data using Bar graphs, Pie charts, and Line graphs (use tools like Excel or Google Sheets)
- Find mean, median, mode
- Discuss trends and patterns
- Submission: Digital presentation or report (PDF or slideshow)

Part B: Mathematics & Humanities:-

(For Roll No. 25 onwards)

Topic: Mathematics in Historical Architecture

- Research any historical monument (e.g., Taj Mahal, Colosseum, Great Pyramid of Giza)
- Identify mathematical concepts used in its construction (symmetry, geometry, ratios, etc.)
- Create a poster or digital report showing: Pictures of the monument, a Mathematical explanation (with diagrams), and a Historical background.

Science:-

- · Revise the topics completed in class and complete your files and registers,
- Do the worksheets given in class in respective subject registers.
- Make the working model on the themes shared with you in the class, and their artwork for the display as assigned to you in your class,

 - Include the Societal Marketing Concept as an additional slide.
